


CABIN AIR FILTERS

Cabin air filters are designed to remove contaminates such as pet dander, dust, soot and exhaust fumes from the air we breathe inside our cab. A dirty cabin air filter can reduce airflow, decreasing the efficiency of the HVAC system and put unnecessary strain on the blower motor. Don't assume that because air is coming out of your vents that it's clean. Your A/C is designed to heat and cool the air, not clean it. Increase your air quality by making sure your cabin air filter is replaced every 12 months or 12,000 miles.
